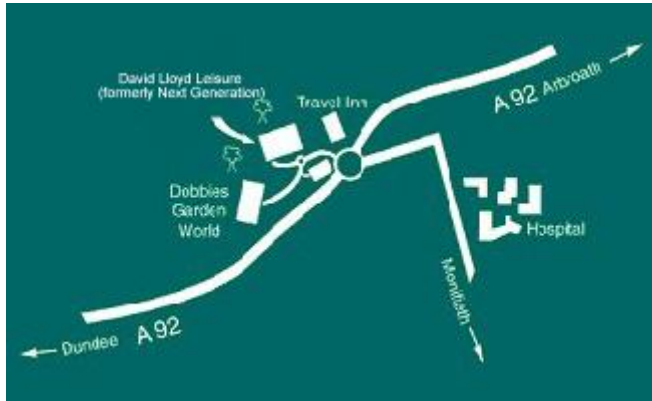


# Venue
